Here are the names of those who were present: Peter, John, James, Andrew, Philip, Thomas, Bartholomew, Matthew, James (son of Alphaeus), Simon (the zealot), and Judas (son of James). They all met together and were constantly united in prayer, along with Mary the mother of Jesus, several other women, and the brothers of Jesus. Acts 1:13-14 (NLT)

Pray because it's for you

You can pray for anything, and if you have faith, you will receive it. Matthew 21:22 (NLT)

He will pay attention to the prayer of the destitute and will not despise their prayer. Psalm 102:17 (HCSB)

May God be praised! He has not turned away my prayer or turned His faithful love from me. Psalm 66:20 (HCSB)

The LORD has heard my plea for help; the LORD accepts my prayer. Psalm 6:9 (HCSB)
