Accept their uniqueness completely

Ephesians 2:10 NLT

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

2 ways we attack their uniqueness:

- Compare them with others

Galatians 6:4 NLT

Pay careful attention to your own work, for then you will get the satisfaction of a job well done, and you won't need to compare yourself to anyone else.

- Try to Conform them to the 'norm'

Romans 12:2 NIV

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Affirm their value constantly

Matthew 10:29-31 NLT

What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.

3 ways we affirm their value:

- Visual attention

Psalms 121:8 NIV

The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

- Physical affection

Hosea 11:4 NIV

I led them with cords of human kindness, with ties of love. To them I was like one who lifts a little child to the cheek, and I bent down to feed them.

- Verbal appreciation

Exodus 19:5 ...my most precious possession

Proverbs 7:2 ...the apple of your eye

Psalms 139:17 ...precious are your thoughts about me
