- Eros a romantic or passionate love
- Agape an unconditional or unrestrained love

Authentic love is not transactional!

John 15:12 NLT

This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you.

Real love proves itself

Romans 5:8 HCSB

But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!

1 Corinthians 13:4-5 NLT

Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. <u>It does not demand its own way</u>. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged.

Real love sacrifices itself

1 John 3:16 NLT

We know what <u>real love</u> is because Jesus gave up his life for us.

So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters.

Real love commits itself

1 John 4:10 NLT

This is <u>real love</u>—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.
