Malachi 3:1 NLT

"Look! I am sending my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me. Then the Lord you are seeking will suddenly come to his Temple. The messenger of the covenant, whom you look for so eagerly, is surely coming," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

God is never in a hurry and He's never late!

2 Peter 3:9 NIV

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

Isaiah 55:8-11 NLT

Wait Expectantly

Luke 2:25, 38 NLT

At that time there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon. He was righteous and devout and was <u>eagerly</u> <u>waiting</u> for the Messiah to come and rescue Israel...

...She (Anna) came along just as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been <u>waiting expectantly</u> for God to rescue Jerusalem.

Listen Intently

Luke 2:25b-32 NLT

The Holy Spirit was upon him and had <u>revealed to him</u> that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah. That day the <u>Spirit led him</u> to the Temple. So when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required, Simeon was there. He took the child in his arms and praised God, saying,

"Sovereign Lord, now let your servant die in peace, as you have promised. I have seen your salvation, which you have prepared for all people. He is a light to reveal God to the nations, and he is the glory of your people Israel!"

Worship Fully

Luke 2:36-37 NIV

There was also a prophet, Anna, the daughter of Penuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was very old; she had lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, and then was a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple but worshiped night and day, fasting and praying.

2 Corinthians 1:20 NLT

For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding "Yes!" And through Christ, our "Amen" (which means "Yes") ascends to God for his glory.
