Jesus doesn't reject us for our doubt,

- Peter doubted, Jesus rescued
- Thomas doubted, Jesus proved (Jn 20:27)
- Disciples doubted, Jesus sent (Matt 28:17-19)
- John the Baptist doubted, Jesus reassured (Matt 11:4-5)
- Martha doubted, Jesus comforted (Jn 11:21-25)

Jesus meets us with grace

John 1:14 NIV

Jesus meets us with compassion

Mark 1:40-41 NLT

A man with leprosy came and knelt in front of Jesus, begging to be healed.

“If you are willing, you can heal me and make me clean,” he said.

Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. “I am willing,” he said. “Be healed!”

Jesus meets us with a question

Matthew 14:31 NLT

Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him. “You have so little faith,” Jesus said.

“Why did you doubt me?”

Come to Me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
